MULE & DONKEY SHOW CLASSES:

- **Open/Amateur/Junior/Senior/Miniature/AGMA:** \$15 per class. Unless otherwise stated below. **Youth:** \$10 per class. **Flat Fee Entry:** \$220/per Mule or \$180/per Donkey.
 Flat Fee **does not** cover the Stake Races or Jackpot Team Sorting.
- **POST-ENTRIES:** Entries received after September 15, 2011 ADD \$2 / PER CLASS. Flat Fee Add \$25/per mule or donkey. Added classes & new entries accepted until 5 p.m. night before the class.
- **Fees received after September 15th must be cash, cashiers check or money order unless prior arrangements have been made to show management.**
- **EXTREME TRAIL CHALLENGE ENTRY FEE \$25, open to horses, mules and donkeys.** Payback for the challenge is 1st \$40, 2nd \$30, 3rd \$20, 4th \$10 see separate entry form Extreme Trail Challenge
- **NASMA FEE:** \$2 per animal entered (*Does Not Apply to Miniatures*)
- **OFFICE/ Grounds FEE:** \$20 per animal entered
- **STALLS:** \$20 per night (Fri., Sat. & Sun). 1 animal per stall, Miniatures are allowed 2 per stall. Price **does not** include shavings; you can bring your own or purchase them at the show at the current rate.
No overnight tieouts.
- **CAMPING & Electric Fees:** Fees collected by Kay Rodgers Park \$20/ per night
- **Admission:** Exhibitors will receive 1 free admission for each animal entered all others will need to purchase admission pass. \$6 Day or 3 day pass at \$15.00 Children under 10 are free.
- **Management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.**

AGMA Animals do have to be registered to compete.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses, mules and donkeys are subject to Arkansas Law which requires current Coggins test 12 months to date of show. In addition, out of state animals must have a 30-day health certificate for ALL horses, mules and donkeys except suckling foals. http://tarlton.law.utexas.edu/dawson/eia/mo_eia.ttm
