- **Open/Amateur/Junior/Senior/ Draft:** \$10 per class. Unless otherwise stated.
- **Youth:** \$5 per class
- **POST-ENTRIES:** Entries received after July 3, 2010 ADD \$2 / PER CLASS Added classes & new entries accepted until 5 p.m. night before the class.
- **Fees received after July 3rd must be cash, cashiers check or money order unless prior arrangements have been made to show management.**
- **EXTREME TRAIL CHALLENGE ENTRY FEE \$20, open to horses, mules and donkeys.** Payback for the challenge is 1st \$25, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$15, 4th \$10 **see separate entry form Extreme Trail Challenge**
- **PAYBACKS FOR ALL CLASSES ARE:**
 1ST \$15, 2ND \$10, 3RD \$5, 4TH \$5 unless otherwise stated.
- **NASMA FEE:** \$2 per animal entered
- **OFFICE FEE:** \$15 per animal entered
- **STALLS:** \$20 per night (Fri., Sat. & Sun). 1 animal per stall, Price **does not** include shavings; you can bring your own or purchase them at the show at the current rate.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: All horses, mules and donkeys are subject to Arkansas Law which requires current Coggins test 12 months to date of show.
